

Giving Circle Grant Guidelines (2025)

The <u>Giving Circle</u> is Centre Foundation's membership-based group of community-minded individuals who pool their resources to support dynamic programs and projects in Centre County. The group gathers and votes at an annual reception to determine which of three finalist organizations will receive a \$10,000+ grant.

Grants typically range from \$2,500 - \$15,000 and may support new or existing programs that positively benefit Centre County.

Eligibility Requirements

- This opportunity is open to 501(c)(3) nonprofit charitable organizations that are registered with the Pennsylvania Bureau of Charitable Organizations unless otherwise exempt.
- Funding must be used to support programs or projects in Centre County that comply with Centre Foundation's <u>Nondiscrimination Policy</u>.
- If selected as a finalist, one or two representatives from the applicant organization must be available to attend the Giving Circle reception on October 14.
- Organizations are eligible to receive a Giving Circle grant once every three years.
 (Giving Circle finalists must skip two years before re-applying.)

Timeline

- Tuesday, July 8 Giving Circle online grant application form opens.
- Thursday, August 21 Deadline to submit a Giving Circle grant application.
- **Friday, September 26** Following a round of online voting by Giving Circle members, applicants will be notified as to whether they are advancing as Giving Circle finalists on or before September 26, 2025.
- Tuesday, October 14 Finalists are required to attend and present seven-minute pitches to the full membership at the Giving Circle reception.
- During the reception, one \$10,000+ grant and two runners-up grants will be awarded that night based on a live vote by Giving Circle members.

Additional Information

Submission: Applications must be submitted through <u>Foundant</u>, Centre Foundation's online application portal on or before August 21, 2025. Application questions can be found at the end of this document.

Budget: The application requires a detailed budget. Please specify how requested grant funds will be used. Be detailed (i.e., 25 calculators @ \$10 each = \$250.00). You may download and use this simple Excel budget template.

Limitations: The Giving Circle does not fund annual/capital campaigns, individuals, endowments, debt reduction, or projects that will be completed prior to the grant award.

Notification: Giving Circle members will review submitted applications and conduct an online vote to determine which three organizations will proceed as finalists. Applicants will be notified as to whether they are advancing as finalists by September 26, 2025, via email.

Tie-Breaking: In the event of a tie during the initial round of voting, finalists will be chosen by random selection; In the event of a tie during the final vote at the reception, there will be an additional tie-breaker vote during the event.

Grant Period: Funding from this grant must be spent by December 31, 2026.

Reporting: Organizations that receive Giving Circle funding are required to attend an Impact Celebration hosted by Centre Foundation in Summer 2026 to provide an update on the grant to the Giving Circle membership.

Foundant Grant Portal
