

Centre PACT Grant Guidelines (2026)

<u>Centre PACT</u> (Philanthropic Actions Created by Teens) is Centre Foundation's hands-on philanthropy program for high school students in Centre County. Throughout the program, students identify issues affecting their peers, solicit and review grant applications, and distribute grants to local nonprofits that will have a positive impact on youth in our community. Centre PACT students are responsible for developing grant recommendations for the annual distribution from the Foundation's <u>Centre PACT Fund</u>, a permanent endowment fund which supports this program, as well as conducting fundraising activities in support of their grants.

All types of youth-serving organizations are encouraged to apply but students are most interested in funding projects or programs that pertain to:

- Basic Needs Access: Human Services, Housing & Food Security, etc.
- Education Access: STEM, Extra Curricular Activities, etc.
- Environment: Conservation, Climate Change, Parks, etc.
- Health and Wellness: Mental Health, Nutrition, Sports and Active Lifestyle, etc.

Eligibility

- This opportunity is open to 501(c)(3) nonprofit charitable organizations that are registered with the Pennsylvania Bureau of Charitable Organizations unless otherwise exempt.
- Funding must be used to address issues that impact young people (Pre-K–12) in Centre County, Pennsylvania.
- Funding must be used to support programs/projects that comply with Centre Foundation's <u>Nondiscrimination Policy</u>.
- Recipient organizations are required to attend Centre PACT's year-end celebration in June 2026 and, in lieu of a grant report, must provide an update on the funded project at a Centre PACT meeting in Fall 2026.

Important Dates

- Tuesday, December 2, 2025 Centre PACT online grant application opens.
- Thursday, January 15, 2026, at 11:59 pm Deadline to submit an application.
- **Before April 30, 2026** Notification of grant awards.
- **Spring 2026** Recipients attend Centre PACT's year-end celebration.
- Fall 2026 Recipients provide project update to Centre PACT.

Instructions

Due Date: Applications are due by 11:59 pm on **Thursday, January 15, 2026**. Applications must be submitted through <u>Foundant</u>, Centre Foundation's online application portal, Please do not email, fax, physically mail, or hand-deliver your proposal. Application questions can be found at the end of this document.

Applicants will be notified of grant decisions in April 2026 and grant awards will be issued in June.

Budget: The online application requires a detailed budget. Please specify how requested grant funds will be used. Be detailed (i.e., 25 calculators @ \$10 each = \$250.00). You may download and use this simple Excel budget template.

The maximum grant amount you may request is \$5,000. Grant award amounts typically range from \$500 to \$3,000, and the average amount awarded is \$1,400.

Reporting: Organizations that receive Centre PACT funding are required to attend the end-of-year celebration in May 2026 to accept the grant award. Organizations are also required to provide a project update at a future Centre PACT meeting.
